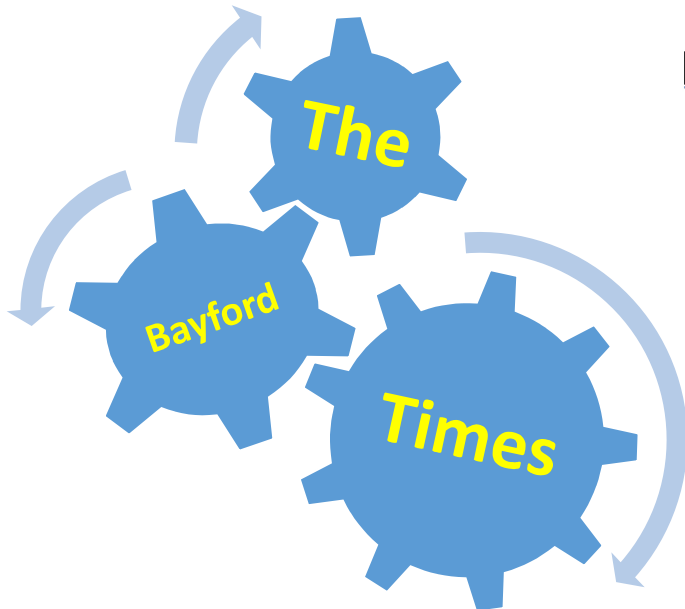
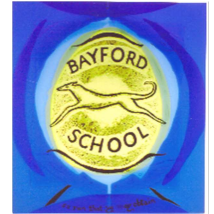

Fund Raising

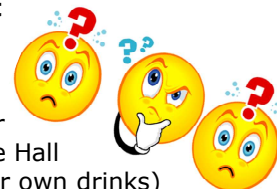
Thank you for your donations for Jeans for Genes/Breast Cancer Day, which we held just before half-term.
