Hertford, Ware and District Primary Schools Music Festival

As you should already know, the children of Class 3 are taking part in the Hertford, Ware and District Music Festival. The children will join a number of other schools to perform *The Mousehole Cat* by Paul Burrell. Our performance will take place on the evening of Wednesday 21st March at The Drill Hall in Ware. Please note, this is different to the Albert Hall Gala and **ALL** children are taking part in this event.

Preparations The children have already learnt the songs but they now need to learn them off by heart. They have been given a copy of the words but the music can be found at: <http://pburrell.uk/songs/> Please encourage your child to practise - often!

Rehearsal 1 Thursday 8th February at Morgans School in Hertford at 9.15am - 12.00pm. Children will work on all the pieces with our fantastic conductor Naveen Arles and sing with children from other schools. Children should take along a bottle of water and a piece of fruit for a snack.

Rehearsal 2 Wednesday 21st March at the Drill Hall, Ware. 9.30 am until 1.00pm (this is the day of our actual performance). Children should take a bottle of water, a snack **and a packed lunch**. At this rehearsal, and in the performance, there will be a live band accompanying the children.

Children need to be taken to and from both sets of rehearsals. Please remember you can only volunteer to help others with transport if you have had your documents checked with Mrs Sims. Please indicate on the attached form if you are able to help with driving or if your child needs a lift back to school. **Please do not arrange lifts yourselves.** It is very difficult for Mrs Sims to arrange lifts when parents have tried to be helpful and done so themselves. Please read the forms carefully and cross out the sections that do not apply to you.

Dress for the performance Children should wear black/dark trousers/leggings and black shoes with a PLAIN BLUE t-shirt (any shade of blue) with **no logos on**. These can be bought very cheaply from supermarkets.
